The scholarships and their respective criteria are herein listed:

The K. Leroy Irvis Undergraduate Scholarship (3)

ONE of these \$1000 scholarships will be awarded in each of the regions (Eastern, Central & Western) in Pennsylvania to undergraduate students who meet these criteria.

- Outstanding Scholarship.
- Extracurricular activity participation.
- Leadership qualities.
- Interpersonal qualities as alluded to by the student's references.

- Essay in no more than five typewritten, double-spaced pages on "Why I should Receive the W. Terrell Jones
 Educational Equity Scholarship."

The Robert D. Lynch SLDI Scholarship (1)

ALL of the criteria listed under the K. Leroy Irvis Scholarship category and:

- Participation in the SLDI conference.
- Essay in no more than five typewritten, double-spaced pages on "Why I should Receive the Robert D. Lynch SLDI Scholarship."

The Esther-Jafari Haymon Scholarship (1)

The successful recipient of this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Valid registration at a college or university in Pennsylvania with a financial need.
- Grade Point Average 2.0 and above.
- Be at least in sophomore year of matriculation.
- Student must demonstrate leadership skills and participation in co-curricular activities.
- Three letters of recommendation are required. One of the three letters of recommendation <u>MUST</u> come from your Financial Aid Office stipulating your need.
- Essay in no more than five typewritten, double-spaced pages on "Why I Should Receive the Esther Jafari Haymon Scholarship."

The John S. Shropshire Graduate Scholarship (1)

ALL of the criteria listed under the K. Leroy Irvis Scholarship category and:

- Earned six graduate credits/hours of study (minimum)
- Essay in no more than five typewritten, double-spaced pages on "Why I Should Receive the John S. Shropshire Graduate Scholarship."
